THE COVER FLOWER

The cover flower is a new *C. reticulata* hybrid developed by Meyer Piet. The bloom shown on the cover is the variegated form of 'EMMA GAETA.' This cultivar was the result of a cross of 'Cornelian' X 'Mouchang.' The seedling first bloomed in 1975 from seed picked in 1972. The original cultivar is a deep rose pink, very large, semi-double with folded up-right center petals. The variegated form is even more striking.
