Species Japonica

- AMANDA ANN** - Dark Red. Medium, formal double. Vigorous, upright and spreading growth. VE. (U.S. 2014 - Steve and Gayle Lawrence).
- AMY CONNOR** - Red variegated white with Yellow anthers and **White** filaments. **Medium to large, loose peony to rose form double**. Average, spreading growth. **E-M**. (U.S. 2013 - Parker Connor, Edisto Island, SC).
- AMY DOODLE** - **Light Pink center with Cream White edges** with Yellow anthers and translucent White filaments. Large, semidouble to loose peony. Average, spreading and open growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 - Gabriel C. Olsen, Pensacola, FL).
- ANDREW** - Light Pink with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. **Very large**, semidouble to full peony. **The petals are heavily veined**. Slow, upright, dense growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 - William Howell, Wilmington, NC).
- APRIL BLUES** - Rose-Red. In cold weather can be Bluish Pink to Purple. Medium, formal double. Vigorous, upright, spreading growth. The plant is very cold hardy. L. (Japonica 'Bernice Body' x Japonica 'Kuro-tsubaki'). (U.S. 2014 - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).
- BALUSTRADE** - Scarlet Red. Small, single. Very narrow, upright growth. (Seeds from NW South Korea - Barry Yinger, et al - before 1986). (U.S. 2011 - Morris Arboretum, Philadelphia, PA).
- BARBARA GRACE** - Purple with deep Maroon center shading with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. **Large, semidouble to rose form double to formal double. Most often formal double**. Average, upright growth. M. (U.S. 2013 - Howell).
- BENTEN MRS. R. L. WHEELER** - Pink. Medium, formal double. (U.S. - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).
- BESSIE BATTLE** - White with Golden stamens and White filaments. Medium to large, semidouble to loose peony form. The petals are wavy and notched at the end. Average, upright, spreading growth. M. (U.S. 1999 - Tom Dodd Nurseries, Semmes, AL).
- BISHÔNEN (BEAUTIFUL BOY)** - Pink background with a peppering of deeper Pink and Carmine stripes with Golden anthers. Large, semidouble - Higo style. Spreading growth. M-L. (Sport of Higo 'Shintsukasa-nishiki'). (Japan 1969 - Ohta Nursery, Kumamoto).
- BLOOMFIELD (MORRIS)** - Scarlet Red. Small, single. Vigorous, fully branched to ground growth. (Seeds from NW South Korea - Barry Yinger, et al - before 1986). (U.S. 2011 - Morris Arboretum, Philadelphia, PA).
- BRIAN'S DAWN** - Light Red with darker Red stripes with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium, semidouble to anemone form. Average, upright growth. E. (U.S. 2012 — Brian S. Dick, Lakeland, FL). (**Mistakenly entered as BRIAN'S DREAM**).
- C. M. GORDY** - Bright Pink with Gold anthers and Cream filaments. Large, semidouble with creped and ruffled petals. Vigorous, dense growth. E-M. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).
- CAROL'S KATIE** - Pink to Rose Pink with bright Yellow anthers and White to translucent filaments. Medium, semidouble. **The flowers are fragrant**. Average, dense and open growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 - Carol Comber, Pensacola, FL).
- CARTER'S SUNBURST SPECIAL** - Medium Pink with deeper Pink veining and an irregular white border with bright Yellow anthers and White filaments. Large to very large, semidouble to loose peony to rose form double. The bloom is occasionally striped dark Pink to Red. Bloom won Best Sport in Charleston 2014 Winter Show. Vigorous, upright growth. E-L. (sport of 'Carter's Sunburst'). (U.S. 2014 - Tommy Alden, Byron, GA).
- CHARLIE ADAMS** - Bright Red variegated White with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. **Large**, semidouble. Average, upright, open growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 - Robert A. Stroud, Slidell, LA).
- CHÛJÔHAKU** - Pure White with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Large, single - Higo form, occasionally anemone. Slow, spreading growth. E-L. (Japan 1934 - Kansai District).
- CURLY LADY** - Red. Medium, semidouble to peony. Twisted branches and leaves. M. (Sport of Japonica 'Lady Campbell'). (Netherlands 2008 - Van Vliet New Plants).
- DARLEEN GRACE** - Cream White with a touch of Pink on the outer petals with Gold anthers and Cream filaments. Medium, semidouble to loose peony. It sometimes blooms Blush Pink with darker Pink late in the season. Average, upright growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

DEBUTANTE BENTEN - Pink. Medium, full peony. Vigorous, upright growth. E-M. (Leaf sport of Japonica 'Debutante'). (U.S. 2002 - Shirley Real).

DESERT SUNSET – Bright Coral Pink with bright Gold anthers and Cream filaments. Large, semidouble. The flower has retic-like characteristics and will sometime have rabbit ears in cooler weather. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. M. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

EGAO - Light Pink. Large, single with circular White stamens. See Higo. (**Not to be confused with Vernalis 'Egao' – a separate variety**).

ELIZABETH DOWD MYSTIQUE - White to pale Pink with darker Pink water marking with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Large, semidouble **to rose form double**. Average, upright and open growth. M-L. (Sport of Japonica 'Elizabeth Dowd Silver'). (U.S. 2013 - James & Elaine Smelley).

ELLEN DANIEL RED – Bright Red. Miniature to small, formal double to peony form. Average, upright growth. M. (Color sport of Japonica 'Ellen Daniel'). (U.S. 1980's)

ELLEN DANIEL RED VARIEGATED – Bright Red with vivid White mottling. Miniature to small, formal double to peony form. Average, upright growth. M. (Virus variegated form of Japonica 'Ellen Daniel Red'). (U.S. 1980's)

ENCHANTED EVENING - Deep Lavender with bright Gold anthers and Pink filaments. Medium, anemone. The blooms have many tightly clustered petaloids mingled with bright gold stamens. Average, open growth. M. (Japonica 'Edna Campbell' seedling). (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

ESTHER ANN - Light Red variegated White. Large, formal double. Average, upright growth. E-M. (U.S. 1977 - Gilley)

EVENSONG - Medium Pink. Medium, formal double. Average, upright growth. E-M (U.S. 2013 – Gordy)

GAYLE BEARDON - Vibrant red with Golden anthers and Golden filaments. Large, semidouble to loose peony to anemone. There is some petal fimbriation. Vigorous, upright and spreading growth. M-L. (U.S. 2014 - Vi & Hank Stone, Baton Rouge, LA).

GORDY'S PRETTY LADY - Clear Pink. Large to very large, semidouble to loose peony form with soft Yellow stamens. Average, open and upright growth. E-L. (U.S. 2005 - Gordy). (**Previously invalidly named Japonica 'Pretty Lady'**).

HAPPY TALK - Soft Coral Red with Gold anthers and Cream filaments. Medium, loose peony to rose form double. Average, upright growth. (Japonica 'Happy Times' seedling). (U.S. 2013 - Gordy).

HENRY PARRISH - Dark Red. Medium, loose peony to semidouble and rarely formal double. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. M. (U.S. 2007 - Hulyn Smith).

HENRY VIII - Deep Rose-Pink (also has variegated form) with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium, semidouble to full peony. Petaloids and stamens within lower petals are also common. Vigorous, upright growth. E. (U.S. 1938-1939 - G. Gerbing, Fernandino, FL).

JIM FINLAY'S FRAGRANT - Light Red. Medium, peony form. Average growth. E-L. Fragrant. (N.Z. 1994 — J. Finlay, Whangarei).

JERRY CONRAD - Rose-Red with Yellow anthers and Cream filaments. Large, semidouble to loose peony. Vigorous, upright growth. M. ('Moonlight Bay' seedling). (U.S. 2014 - Jerry Conrad, Mt. Plymouth, FL).

JESSICA BEACH - Pink with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium, semidouble to full peony to rose form double. Vigorous, upright growth. M. (**Japonica 'Angel's Blush' seedling**). (U.S. 2013 - Miles A Beach, Mt. Pleasant, SC).

JOHNNY LAMEY, III – Medium Red with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Large to Very large, semidouble. The stamens spread out into five parts. Average, upright, dense growth. M. (U.S. 2013 – Howell)

JOHNSON VAN CATHERINE - Deep Rose Pink with White dapples at outside of petals with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium, semidouble. The petaloids divert the stamens. Bloom won Best Sport in Columbia 2013 Winter Show. Vigorous, upright growth. M-L. (sport of 'Eugene Bolen'). (U.S. 2014 - Catherine Johnson, Perry, GA).

JULUIS NUCCIO- Brilliant dark Red. Large to very large, irregular semidouble. Vigorous upright growth, M-L (U.S. 2014 - Nuccio's Nurseries, Altadena, CA)

KOREAN SNOW - Pure White with Golden anthers and Yellow filaments. Medium, single. Upright, open growth. E. (Seeds from NW South Korea - Barry Yinger, et al - before 1986). (U.S. - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).

KYLE WHITE - White with Yellow anthers and White filaments. **Medium**, semidouble to rose form double. The edges of each petal have a notch in the center. Average, upright, open growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 - Barbara Kyle, New Iberia, LA).

LADY IDA PEARL — White. Large, formal double. Vigorous, spreading dense growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 – Tom Sellers, Bolivia, NC).

LAURA GORDY – Soft Pink with Gold anthers and Cream filaments. Medium, semidouble to rose form double. Average, spreading growth. M. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

LILA S. ROBERTS - Light Pink with darker Pink stripes and flecks with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium, rose form double to formal double. Average, upright and dense growth. M. (U.S. 2014 - Lawrence and Lila Roberts).

LILIANE WELLS — White, sometimes with Blush throat and Pink stripes. Very large, anemone form. Average, spreading, upright growth. E-M. (U.S. 1963 — H. Wilson, Fresno, CA).

LOUISE FITZGERALD - Creamy Pink with lighter outer markings with Creamy Golden anthers and Creamy Golden filaments. Large to very large, semidouble. Rapid, upright, spreading growth. E-M. (Sport of Japonica 'Sweetie Pie'). (U.S. 2007 – Jerry Conrad, Plymouth, FL).

MADAME HAAS - Light Red with more deeply colored veins with a floral center marked light Pink. Medium, formal double. Vigorous, upright growth. M. (France 1879 - E. Haas).

MAGIC TOUCH – Soft Pink with light Gold anthers and Pink filaments. Large, semidouble. Average, upright growth. M. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

MAIDEN OF GREAT PROMISE - Pink. Medium to large, peony. Compact growth. The plant is very cold hardy. L. (U.S. 2008 - Ohio).

MARY ANN LAWRENCE - Bright Red with Yellow anthers and White filaments. **Large**, semidouble. **There is a vivid contrast of red petals and yellow stamens.** Average, spreading, dense growth. M-L. (Japonica 'Royal Velvet' seedling). (U.S. 2013 - Steve & Gayle Lawrence, Tallahassee, FL).

MOMOIRO BOKUHAN - Dark Rose outer petals with Rose petaloids fringed with White with light Yellow stamens. Miniature to small, anemone. Very slow, dense growth. Very cold hardy. E-M. (Japan 1960 - Kansai area).

MONDAY'S CHILD – Deep Pink with bright Gold anthers and Pink filaments. Large, anemone form. Average, upright growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

MORRIS MERCURY - Red. Small, single. Open, upright, arching growth. E. (Seeds from NW South Korea - Barry Yinger, et al - before 1986). (U.S. 2011 - Morris Arboretum, Philadelphia, PA).

NIGHTFALL - Dark Red with very dark veins with bright Gold anthers and Pink filaments. Medium, single. Vigorous, upright growth. VE-M. (Japonica 'Royal Velvet' seedling). (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

NUCCIO'S CAMEO VARIEGATED - Light Pink to Coral Pink blotched White variation of Nuccio's Cameo. (U.S. 2014).

OYLER'S SYDNEY - Fuchsia and White with Golden anthers and Cream filaments. Medium, full peony. Slow, upright and dense growth. M-L. (U.S. 2014 - Donald R. Oyler, Mobile, AL).

PAULA DEEN - Soft Red with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium, semidouble to anemone. Slow, upright growth. M-L. (U.S. 2014 - Lillian Gordy, Ocala, FL).

PINK RIBBON - Pink with minor variegation. **Medium to large**, formal double. Average, upright, dense growth. **The plant is very cold hardy.** M-L. (U.S. 2013 - Howell).

POP'S PERFECTION PEPPERMINT - Burgundy stripes on a Pink background. Tendency to sport single colored flower. Small, formal double. Very slow growth. M-L. (U.S. - John Davy, Milton, FL).

PURPLE PASSION - Reddish Purple **center to deep Purple outer petals with dark Purple radial veining**. Medium, formal double. **The Purple coloration holds true through most of the bloom season but extremely late blooms lose some of the Blue pigment**. Average, upright, dense growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 - Richard Dodd, Marshallville, GA).

RENA CAMPBELL - Variable: Rose to solid Red, White, White with Red stripes, and medium Pink with stripes and flecks of deeper Pink. Medium, loose peony form. Vigorous, upright, bushy growth. M-L. (Seed parent of 'Mrs. F. L. Gibson' and seed grandparent of 'Betty Sheffield'). (U.S. 1890-1900 – Loui Lauraine Campbell, Quitman, GA).

RICHARD GORDY – Deep Red with bright Gold anthers and Pink filaments. Medium, semidouble. The petals often have a waxy look. Average, upright, dense growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

RILYN BOUERES - Lavender variegated White with bright Yellow anthers and White filaments. **Medium to large**, semidouble. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 - Howard & Mary Rhodes, Tallahassee, FL).

ROSEMARIE OSTBERG - Very dark Pink with Gold anthers and White filaments. Medium, semidouble to anemone. Average, upright growth. M. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

RUPIE - White with stripes or spots of dark Pink sometimes producing a flower Pink on one half and White on the other half **with Gold anthers and Yellow filaments**. Medium to large, semidouble to loose peony. Average, upright growth. M. (U.S. 2013 - Rupert E. Drews, Charleston, SC).

RYAN GAINNEY - Pale to Blush Pink on the center petals progressing to deep Pink on the outer petals with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Large, semidouble. The bloom has pointed petals in the center and outer petals. Average, upright growth. M-L. ('Magnoliaeflora' seedling). (U.S. 2014 - Ryan Gainey, Decatur, GA).

SAN DIMAS - Dark Red. Medium to large, semidouble with irregular petals. Average, compact growth. E-M. (U.S. 1971 - **Nuccio's**).

SAN DIMAS VARIEGATED — Dark Red blotched White variation of 'San Dimas'. (U.S. 1971 - **Nuccio's**).

SCARLET RIBBONS - Vibrant Red with Gold anthers and Cream filaments. Medium, loose peony to rose form double. Average, spreading, open growth. E-L. (Japonica 'Jean Clere' seedling). (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

SHIRO-HAGOROMO (WHITE HAGOROMO) - White. Medium, semidouble (lotus form - hose-in-hose). Average, compact growth. M-L. (Japonica 'Magnoliaeflora' seedling). (Japan 1975 - Shigeichi Yagi, Ehime).

STEPHEN GORDY – Deep Pink with bright Gold anthers and Pink filaments. Medium, semidouble. Vigorous, upright growth. E-M. 2013).

SUE KENDALL - **Medium Pink**. Miniature, formal double. Vigorous, open, upright growth. E-L. (U.S. 1998 — D. Kendall, Modesto, CA).

SUMMER PEARL - Very light Pink with Red or Pink stripes with Yellow anthers and White filaments. **Small**, semidouble to loose peony to rose form double. Vigorous, upright, spreading growth. E-L. (U.S. 2013 - James & Elaine Smelley).

SWEET AUBURN - RHSCC 66D - moderate Purplish Pink with Yellow anthers and Yellow-White filaments. Very large, semidouble. Vigorous, upright growth. M-L. (U.S. 2014 - Unknown origin, Auburn, AL).

SWEETIE PIE RED – Mauve Red with Creamy Golden anthers and Creamy Golden filaments. Large to very large, semidouble. Rapid, upright, spreading growth. E-M. (Color sport of Japonica 'Sweetie Pie'). (U.S. 2005 – Jerry Conrad, Plymouth, FL).

TAMA CAROUSEL - Pink with a White border. Medium, semidouble with center petals that standup and occasional petaloids. Medium, upright, bushy growth. E-M. (Japonica 'Tama-no-ura' X Japonica 'Nuccio's Carousel'). (U.S. 2014 - Bradford King, Arcadia, CA).

VIRGIE'S EDEN - Baby ribbon Pink with Yellow anthers and Cream filaments. Medium, rose form double. The petals are incurved. Vigorous, upright growth. M-L. (U.S. 2014 - Manson Markette, Americus, GA).

WARREN THOMPSON - Deep Pink with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Large, semidouble. average, spreading growth. M. (U.S. 2014 - Marvin Jernigan, Warner Robbins, GA).

WENDY RED – Dark Red. Large, semidouble, Average, upright, open growth. E-L. (Red form of Japonica 'Wendy'). (U.S. 1976 – Gilley).

- WISHING STAR** - Light Pink. Medium to large, semidouble to anemone form with star-shaped outer petals. Vigorous, compact, upright growth. M. (U.S. 1958 - McCaskill).
- WITCH DOCTOR** - Rose Red. Large, semidouble to rose form double. Average, compact growth. E-M. (U.S. 1960 — G. Demetropolis, Mobile, AL).
- WITMAN YELLOW** - White tinged Yellow. Medium, semidouble. Average, upright growth. M. (U.S. 1963 — Witman).
- WOBBY BOY** - White, flecked and blotched light Pink, shading to darker Pink. Medium, semidouble. Average, compact, upright growth. M-L. (U.S. 1983 — W Herbert, Ruston, LA).
- WONDER CHILD** - See 'Betty Sheffield Blush'.
- WONDERLAND** - Brilliant, deep Rose. Large, semidouble to peony form. Vigorous, open growth. M-L. (U.S. 1960 — Short).
- WONDER OF WHITE** - White. Medium, formal double. Vigorous, upright growth. E-M. (U.S. 2002 — Gordon E. Eade, Pensacola, FL).
- WOOD SPRITE** - Blush Pink. Small, semidouble. Vigorous, bushy, upright growth. M. (U.S. 1959 - McCaskill).
- YEAMANS HALL** - Shell Pink with darker Pink striping. Medium, formal double. E-L. (U.S. 2006— Sam Borom. Propagated by Coastal Carolina Camellia Society. Mt. **Pleasant, SC**).

Species Reticulata and Hybrids With Reticulata Parentage

- ADRENE WHEELER** - Medium Pink **with frosted edges** with Yellow anthers and White filaments. **Very large**, semidouble. Vigorous, upright, dense growth. L. (Reticulata hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Reticulata hybrid 'Annabelle Fetterman'). (U.S. 2013 - Hulyn Smith).
- ADRIENNE BOUERES** - Dark Pink with bright Yellow anthers and White filaments. **Medium to large**, rose form double. Average, spreading growth. M-L. (Reticulata hybrid 'Frank Houser' seedling). (U.S. 2013 - Howard & Mary Rhodes, Tallahassee, FL).
- ALI HUNT** - Pink **with darker Pink veining throughout each petal with bright** Yellow anthers **and White filaments**. Large, **semidouble**. Vigorous, upright growth. M-L. (U.S. 2013 - Hulyn Smith).
- BEULAH HENNLy** - Light Pink with Yellow anthers and White filaments. **Large**, semidouble. Vigorous, upright, open growth. L. (U.S. 2013 - Hulyn Smith).
- BLUE TWILIGHT** - Bluish Pink with Yellow anthers and Pinkish filaments. Large, semidouble with ruffled petals. Vigorous, open growth. L. (U.S. 2014 - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).
- ELAINE** - Medium Pink with bright Yellow anthers and White filaments. Very large, semidouble. **The petals are fluted**. Vigorous, upright, spreading growth. **M-L**. (Reticulata hybrid 'Curtain Call' x Reticulata hybrid 'Pleasant Memories'). (U.S. 2013 - James & Elaine Smelley).
- FINE PURE (MIAOJIE)** - Light Pink petals with darker pink edges, sometimes frosted White with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Very large, semidouble. Petals in about three whorls, the inner incurved, the outer flat with emarginated apex. Vigorous, upright growth. M-L. (Reticulata Hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Japonica 'Kona'). (U.S. 2007 – John Wang, Orinda, CA).
- HOLY PURE (SHENG JIE)** - Inner two whorls White lightly tinged Pink, outer whorls slightly darker Pink with light Purple margins, sometimes frosted White with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Large to very large, rose form double to semidouble, Vigorous, upright growth. M-L. (Reticulata hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Japonica 'Kona'). (U.S. 2007 – John Wang, Orinda, CA).
- HULYN'S MEADOWBROOK** - Medium Pink; sometimes frosted White with Gold anthers and White filaments. Very large, semidouble to full peony. The bloom is often fluorescent. Vigorous, upright and spreading growth. M-L. (Reticulata hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Reticulata hybrid 'Frank Houser'). (U.S. 2014 - Hulyn Smith).
- KAI MEI'S CHOICE** - Clear Rose Red. Large, semidouble. Upright, narrow growth. VE-E. (U.S. 1995 – Clifford Parks, Chapel Hill, NC).

LINDA GRIFFIN - **Light** Pink with bright Yellow anthers and White filaments. Very large, semidouble. Vigorous, upright, open growth. M-L. (Reticulata hybrid 'Curtain Call' x Reticulata hybrid 'Pleasant Memories'). (U.S. 2013 - James & Elaine Smelley).

LINDA LEE EHRHART - Silvery Pink with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Large, semidouble. Average, upright, spreading growth. E-L. (**Reticulata hybrid 'Lauretta Feathers' seedling**). (U.S. 2013 - Robert E. Ehrhart, Walnut Creek, CA).

MARY CATHERINE CAPE - Medium Pink **frosted White** with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium, semidouble. Average, upright, open growth. L.. (Reticulata hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Reticulata hybrid 'Annabelle Fetterman'). (U.S. 2013 - Hulyn Smith).

MARY ELIZABETH DOWDEN – Pink, heavily veined, Silver sheen. Medium semidouble form. Average, open and spreading growth. M. (U.S. 2006 – Robert A. Stroud and Charles C. Bush, Slidell, LA).

MARY MAUD SHARPE - Medium to dark Pink with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium, semidouble to loose peony. The bloom is sometimes frosted and is fluorescent. Vigorous, upright and dense growth. M-L. (Reticulata hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Reticulata hybrid 'Annabelle Fetterman'). (U.S. 2014 - Hulyn Smith).

MARY RHODES - Light Pink shading to White with Yellow anthers and White filaments. **Large**, semidouble. Vigorous, upright, spreading growth. L.. (Reticulata hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Reticulata hybrid 'Annabelle Fetterman'). (U.S. 2013 - Hulyn Smith).

NANSHAN PURPLE JADE (NANSHAN ZIYU) – Light Pink to Pink-Purple with Yellow anthers and White filaments. Medium, formal double to rose form double to semidouble. Average, upright growth. M-L. (Reticulata Hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Japonica 'Nuccio's Jewel'). (U.S. 2009 – John Wang, Orinda, CA).

NEDRA ANN MATHIS - Light Pink with Golden anthers and White filaments. Very large, semidouble to peony form. Vigorous, upright, spreading growth. M-L. (Reticulata Hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Reticulata Hybrid 'Jean Pursel'). (U.S. 1996 — Hulyn Smith).

RANDOLPH MAPHIS - Incorrectly classified as a Reticulata and Non-retic Hybrid in the 2009 and 2014 Camellia Nomenclatures. It is a Reticulata only.

ROSE TWILIGHT - Neon Pink. Large, single. Very open growth. (Williamsii 'William Lavender' x Reticulata). (U.S.).

SKIP'S CHOICE - Pale Pink with bright Yellow anthers and White filaments. **Medium**, semidouble. Average, spreading, open growth. L. (Reticulata hybrid 'Phyllis Hunt' seedling). (U.S. 2013 - James & Elaine Smelley).

TITLETOWN USA - Light Pink with Golden Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. **Medium to large**, semidouble. Average, upright growth. M-L. (Reticulata hybrid 'Suzanne Withers' x Reticulata hybrid 'Hulyn Smith'). (U.S. 2009 — Hulyn Smith).

WALTER HOMEYER - Red with heavy frosting with Gold anthers and Gold filaments. Very large, semidouble to peony form. Average, upright, open growth. M-L. (U.S. 2004 — Hulyn Smith).

Hybrids With Other Than Reticulata Parentage

ARCTIC SNOW - White with hints of Pink at petal tips. Large, single. Vigorous, spreading growth. E. (U.S. - Ackerman).

BLUSHING FOUNTAINS - Light Pink. Small, single. Moderate, upright growth with arching branches. L. (C. japonica x C. tsaii). (U.S. 2014 - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).

COMMANDER EDWARD FREDRICKSON - Pale Yellow with dark Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Miniature, **semidouble**. Average, upright, open growth. E-L. (U.S. 2013 - Gena Owens Fredrickson, Wilmington, NC).

DAUGHTER'S RED (NÜ'ERHONG) – Dark Pink with Yellow anthers and White filaments, Large, semidouble with veined petals. Very fragrant. M. (Hybrid 'D3[4]' x Hybrid 'Superscent'). (U.S. 2008 – John Wang, Orinda, CA).

HALLSTONE SPICY - Bright Pink. Small, peony. Upright growth. Spicy fragrance. M. (U.S. 2008 - Ken Hallstone, Lafayette, CA).

JINHUA'S JADE TRAY (YUPAN JINHUA) - White to light Pink or Yellowish with Green tone, edged with Pink with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Large to very large, anemone to peony form. Petals broad and wrinkled or serrated at the

edges and waved. A large number of petaloids mixed with stamens forming a central raised ball. Vigorous, upright growth. Sweetly fragrant. E-L. (Williamsii x fragrant cultivar). (U.S. 2007 – John Wang, Orinda, CA).

MIEKO TANAKA – True Red. Small, single. Average, well branched growth. VE-L. (C. x vernalis ‘Gaisen’ x C. japonica). (Japan – Dr. Tanaka).

PINK SERENADE - Incorrectly classified as a Sasanqua and Hybrid in the 2009 and 2014 Camellia Nomenclatures. It is a Sasanqua only.

SCENTED SNOW - White. Large, anemone. Rapid, upright growth. Especially sweet scent. E. (Sasanqua 'Northern Lights' x Oleifera. (U.S. 2008 - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).

VERNAL BREEZE - White. Small, single. Vigorous, upright growth. Very fragrant. The plant has long arching branches. E. (C. japonica X C. lutchuensis). (U.S. 2014 - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).

WINTER'S BEAUTY CHARTREUSE - Pink. Small, semidouble. Average, upright, dense growth. Cold hardy. E-M. (Sport of Hybrid 'Winter's Beauty'). (U.S. - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).

Species Sasanqua

AGLAIA – Pink shading to a darker almost Wine-colored center. Medium to large, peony. Vigorous spreading growth. (U.S. 1995 – Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

ANGEL'S KISS - Pink. Medium, peony. Rapid, upright growth. E. (U.S. 2008 - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).

AUTUMN CARNIVAL - White with small Pink radial stripes with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Small, single. Slow, upright growth. E. (Sasanqua 'Twilight Glow' seedling). (U.S. 2014 - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).

DAYDREAM BELIEVER – Pure White. Medium, single. Fast, upright growth. Fragrant. E. (U.S. 2000 – Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

FEATHERED EDGE – White to Blush gradually darkening toward the edge and having feathered streaks radiating toward the center. Medium, semidouble to loose peony. Compact, rounded growth. (U.S. 2005 – Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

HANA-NANA – White bordered with intense deep Pink. Single. Compact growth. (Sasanqua ‘Hana-Jiman’ seedling). (U.S. 1996 - Robert Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

LAURA CLAIRE - Incorrectly classified as a Sasanqua and Japonica in the 2006, 2009 and 2014 Camellia Nomenclatures. It is a Japonica only.

OCTOBER MAGIC BRIDE – (‘Green 99-096’) White. Small to medium, loose peony. Dense, semi-dwarf conical growth. (U.S. 1999 – Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

OCTOBER MAGIC DAWN – (‘Green 99-012’) Soft Peach Pink. Medium to large, rose form double to peony form. Dense, conical to pyramidal growth. L. (U.S. 1999 – Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

OCTOBER MAGIC INSPIRATION – (‘Green 97-039’) White with Pinkish-Violet edges. Medium, peony form. (Sasanqua ‘Mine-no-yuki’ seedling). (U.S. 1997– Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

OCTOBER MAGIC ORCHID – (Green 94-035’) Varying tones of White and orchid Pink. Small to medium, semidouble. Dense, semi-dwarf growth. E-L. (U.S. 2000 – Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

OCTOBER MAGIC ROSE – (‘Green 98-009’) Coral Red. Small, peony form. Columnar growth. (U.S. 1999 – Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

OCTOBER MAGIC RUBY – (‘Green 02-003’) Red. Small to medium, peony form. Dense, semi-dwarf growth. E-L. (U.S. 2002 – Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

OCTOBER MAGIC SNOW – (‘Green 94-010’) White, often edged in Pink and a Pink cast appearing in the center. Medium, peony form . Medium rounded form. (Sasanqua ‘Mine-no-yuki’ seedling). (U.S. 1994 – Bobby Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

ORCHID MIST – Soft Orchid with soft Gold anthers and Cream filaments. Small to medium, single. Vigorous, upright growth. E. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

PINK PARASOL – Soft Pink with Gold anthers and Pink filaments. Medium, single. Vigorous, upright growth. E. (U.S. 2013 – Gordy).

REVEREND JIM JEFFREY – Deep Purple with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Miniature, semidouble to loose peony form. The plant has a semi-dwarf form. Slow, upright, dense growth. E-M. (U.S. 2013 – Howell).

SUSY DIRR – ('Green 99-031') Bright Pink. Large, formal double. Rapid, bushy growth. (U.S. 1999– Robert Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

THALIA - White flower with outer half suffused with Pink. Miniature, loose peony to rose form double. Dense, semi-dwarf growth. E-M. (U.S. 1996 Robert Green, Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

YULETIDE SPIRIT – Deep Coral Red. Large, single. Dense, upright, spreading growth. U.S. 2000 - Robert Green, Jr., Green Nurseries, Fairhope, AL).

Species Hiemalis

SEIKAIHA (QUIET OCEAN WAVES) - Rose-Pink. Medium, formal double to rose form double. E-M. (Japan - Kumamoto Prefecture).

SHIKISHIMA (POETIC NAME FOR JAPAN) - Medium Pink with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Medium, semidouble. Dense growth. E-M. (Japan - Shishido, Yajirō, Kumamoto Prefecture).

Species Vernalis

EGAO - Deep **Pink, deeper Pink in the lower half of the petals with Yellow Stamens and pale Yellow filaments.** Medium to large, semidouble. **Vigorous upright, somewhat spreading growth. M. (Japan to U.S. 1977 – Nuccio's). (Not to be confused with Japonica 'Egao' – a separate variety).**

EGAO CORKSCREW - Pink. Small to Medium, semidouble to loose peony form with ruffled petals. Distinctive zig-zag growth habit. Average, spreading growth. M. **(Sport of Vernalis 'Egao'). (U.S. 2000 - Nuccio's). (Previously considered to be a non-retic hybrid).**

RYŪKŌ (DRAGON LIGHT) - Deep Red with Yellow anthers and Yellow filaments. Small, single. Fast growth. M-L. (Japan 1972 - Katsuhiko Maeda, Hanamatsu City, Shizuoka Prefecture).

SHIBORI EGAO CORKSCREW - Pink mottled White variation of **Vernalis** 'Egao Corkscrew'. (U.S. 2006 - Nuccio's). **(Previously considered to be a non-retic hybrid).**

Species Edithae

DALU JIUQU (NINE BENDS IN MAINLAND) - Deep Pink. Small to medium formal double. Vigorous spreading growth. Brown calyx. L. (China 2007 – Gao, Jiyin, Fujian Province).

HEIMUDAN (DARK PEONY) – Crimson to Purplish crimson. Medium, peony form with 4 to 5 outer rows, irregularly imbricated. Brown calyx. M. (China 1989 – Gao & Zhuang, Fujian Province).

Species Rusticana (Snow Camellia)

KOSHI-NO-FUBUKI (BLIZZARD OF NIIGATA) - **Red. Small, tubular to campanulate single. (Mutation of a wild C. japonica var. rusticana). (Japan 1956 - Niigata Prefecture).**

TAIYŌ(THE SUN) - Claret Rose with Yellow anthers and Creamy filaments. Small, single. Slow, upright growth. The bloom has broad, overlapping petals, emarginate and slightly crêped, with a compact stamen column. This snow Camellia cultivar has light yellow variegation along the midrib and the major veins of the dark green, glossy leaves. M-L. (Japan 1966 - Niigata Prefecture).

Species Wabisuke

SPRING SONG - Light Pink with Light Yellow anthers and Light Yellow filaments. Small, Single. Flowers open to a trumpet shape. E. (Wabisuke 'Sukiya' seedling). (U.S. 2014 - Camellia Forest, Chapel Hill, NC).

Camellia Species

AMPLEXICAULIS - Purplish Red. Small, single. Leaves oblong-elliptical and very large. Blooms summer and autumn and can flower all year under controlled conditions.

TUNGHINENSIS – Pale Yellow. Small, single. Glossy, medium-size foliage. Average, upright, fairly shrubby growth. M-L. Guangxi Province, China.

Supplement for 1996 & Subsequent Editions

BABY SARGENT - Dark Red. Miniature, full peony form. A boutonniere type resembling Japonica 'Professor Sargent'. M. (U.S. 1936).

CAPTAIN MARTIN'S FAVORITE - Deep Pink splotched White. Medium, formal double to rose form double. Slow, compact, upright growth. M. (Europe to U.S. 1860's - Magnolia).

HORKAN — ('Mille Beaux'; 'Variabilis'; 'Missima'; 'Pearl Marginata'; 'Dan McCarthy'). White striped Red, Pink and Rose and in solid colors. Medium, variform. Vigorous, angular growth. L. (Orient to England 1816). **Not the same variety as Japonica 'Rena Campbell' - 2014.**
