## THE COVER FLOWER

'Spring Deb', this month's cover flower, is a seedling of 'Herme', with the male parent unknown. The bloom is a light pink peony form flower similar to 'Debutante', 31/2" in diameter and 2" high. Blooming time is midseason. The plant growth habits are upright, spreading and dense, with a medium growth rate. It was introduced in the Fall of 1965 by Nuccio's Nurseries of Altadena, California.
